For the second year running, One Up Golf is proud to sponsor ELGA's Order of Merit Award. ELGA's Order of Merit is keenly contested and in 2006 upwards of 500 ladies and girls countrywide took part.

On the 5th December 2006 One Up Golf was pleased to attend ELGA's AGM. Held at the National Motorcycle Museum in Birmingham, it was a lovely opportunity to learn about the organisations developments and to meet some of the members. Vicki Sweet from One Up Golf presented the Ladies Order of Merit Award to Kerry Smith, Mrs Ann McMullen collected the Girls Order of Merit Award on behalf of Kiran Matharu.

The ELGA Order of Merit Award seeks to make a fair comparison between the performance of English lady amateur golfers across a spectrum of scratch tournaments and team events. Points are awarded to all finishing positions down to the 20th in stroke play and last 16 in match play. Each event is classified according to the quality of field and a weighting multiple is applied to the points awarded. County team match results are awarded fixed points. ELGA does not use the Order of Merit to determine team selection; it is one of many factors taken into consideration.

One Up Golf has been associated with the English Ladies Golf Association through the sponsorship of the Order of Merit for the past two years. One Up Golf hugely admires the important work carried out by ELGA. It is thanks to their dedication in promoting and encouraging the amateur game of golf that our sport is enjoying the upsurge in popularity that it so deserves.
